Tips on Gardening:i

"Win the War on Weeds"

(1001 Gardening Secrets, pp.122-123,125)

- Wash weeds with soap. Mix 5 Tbs. of soap with 1 qt. of water, then spray weed leaves liberally on a hot day.
- Give weeds a sip of soda. Try pouring out straight Coca Cola on the weeds in your sidewalks. This sticky soda can knock 'em dead.
- Target weeds with killer technique. Spray individual weeds without catching your favorite plants in the crossfire. Cut off the bottom of a plastic 2-liter soda bottle. Set the bottle over the trouble-making weed, stick the sprayer nozzle in the mouth of the soda bottle, and spray away. Let the chemicals soak in for a few seconds before lifting the bottle.
- Mow weeds more often. More regularly, especially during peak growing times. You'll have a tidier lawn and catch flowering weeds before they set seed. But don't scalp your grass. Mow high, instead. Longer grass blades shade the ground and stop weeds from sprouting.
