Scriptures to consider

I Cor. 15:52 & Rev. 11:15 Our resurrection is at the last Trumpet when Jesus returns to all at the end.

II Peter 3:1-18

I Thes. 1:10; 2:16, 19; 3:4, 13; 4:13 - 5:11, 23. "Coming" from Gk. "parousia" means "manifested appearing."

II Thes. 1:1-2:13. The rapture (v. 2:1) is at the parousia, coming, of the Lord, and what must come first (2:3) before His parousia (2:8), is the "falling away," the *apostasy*, and the parousia (2:9) of the antichrist who is destroyed at the Lord's parousia (2:8).

Jude :14 Gk. αγιαισ, agiais, translated "saints," means "holy ones," referring to holy angels (Mk. 8:38; II Thes. 1:7), not humans.

Rev. 20:4-6 The first resurrection is at the end of the tribulation and age.
