Servant: n.

1. A person in the service of another.

Servant: n. American Dictionary of the English Language, Webster 1828:

1. A person, male or female, that attends another for the purpose of performing menial offices for him, or who is employed by another for such offices or for other labor, and is subject to his command. The word is correlative to *master*. *Servant* differs from *slave*, as the servant's subjection to a master is voluntary, the slave's is not. Every slave is a servant, but every servant is not a slave.

Service: n.

1. In a general sense, labor of body, or of body and mind, performed at the command of a superior, or in pursuance of duty, or for the benefit of another.

- Mt. 4:10 Then Jesus *said to him, "Begone, Satan! For it is written, 'You shall worship the Lord your God, and serve Him only.'"
- Mt. 6:24 "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will hold to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.
- Mt. 20:28 just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many. "

- KJV I Tim. 3:10 And let these also first be proved; then let them use the office of a deacon, being found blameless.
- I Tim. 3:13 For those who have served well as deacons obtain for themselves a high standing and great confidence in the faith that is in Christ Jesus.
- KJV I Tim. 3:13 For they that have used the office of a deacon well purchase to themselves a good degree, and great boldness in the faith which is in Christ Jesus.
- Mt. 20:26 "It is not so among you, but whoever wishes to become great among you shall be your servant,
- KJV Mt. 20:26 But it shall not be so among you: but whosoever will be great among you, let him be your minister;
- Mt. 23:11 "But the greatest among you shall be your servant.
- Mk. 9:35 And sitting down, He called the twelve and *said to them, "If anyone wants to be first, he shall be last of all, and servant of all."
- Lk. 16:13 "No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one, and love the other, or else he will hold to one, and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon."
- Lk. 22:26 "But not so with you, but let him who is the greatest among you become as the youngest, and the leader as the servant.
- KJV Lk. 22:26 But ye shall not be so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.
- Mk. 8:6 And He *directed the multitude to sit down on the ground; and taking the seven loaves, He gave thanks and broke them, and started giving them to His disciples to serve to them, and they served them to the multitude.
- KJV Mk. 8:6 And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before them; and they did set them before the people.
- Jn. 12:26 "If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there shall My servant also be; if anyone serves Me, the Father will honor him.
- Acts 3:13 "The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified His servant Jesus, *the one* whom you delivered up, and disowned in the presence of Pilate, when he had decided to release Him.
- KJV Acts 3:13 The God of Abraham, and of Isaac, and of Jacob, the God of our fathers, hath glorified his Son Jesus; whom ye delivered up, and denied him in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let him go.
- Acts 3:26 "For you first, God raised up His Servant, and sent Him to bless you by turning every one *of you* from your wicked ways."

- KJV Acts 3:26 Unto you first God, having raised up his Son Jesus, sent him to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.
- Acts 4:30 while Thou dost extend Thy hand to heal, and signs and wonders take place through the name of Thy holy servant Jesus. "
- KJV Acts 4:30 By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus.
- Rom. 14:4 Who are you to judge the servant of another? To his own master he stands or falls; and stand he will, for the Lord is able to make him stand.
- Rom. 16:1 I commend to you our sister Phoebe, who is a servant of the church which is at Cenchrea;
- I Tim. 4:6 In pointing out these things to the brethren, you will be a good servant of Christ Jesus, *constantly* nourished on the words of the faith and of the sound doctrine which you have been following.
- KJV I Tim. 4:6 If thou put the brethren in remembrance of these things, thou shalt be a good minister of Jesus Christ, nourished up in the words of faith and of good doctrine, whereunto thou hast attained.
- I Cor. 3:5 What then is Apollos? And what is Paul? Servants through whom you believed, even as the Lord gave *opportunity* to each one.
- KJV I Cor. 3:5 Who then is Paul, and who is Apollos, but ministers by whom ye believed, even as the Lord gave to every man?
- I Cor. 4:1 Let a man regard us in this manner, as servants of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.
- KJV I Cor. 4:1 Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God.
- II Cor. 3:6 who also made us adequate *as* servants of a new covenant, not of the letter, but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.
- KJV II Cor. 3:6 Who also hath made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter killeth, but the spirit giveth life.
- II Cor. 6:4 but in everything commending ourselves as servants of God, in much endurance, in afflictions, in hardships, in distresses,
- KJV II Cor. 6:4 But in all things approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses,
- II Cor. 11:15 Therefore it is not surprising if his servants also disguise themselves as servants of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their deeds.
- KJV II Cor. 11:15 Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works.

- Lk. 2:37 and then as a widow to the age of eighty-four. And she never left the temple, serving night and day with fastings and prayers.
- Acts 6:1 Now at this time while the disciples were increasing {in number,} a complaint arose on the part of the Hellenistic {Jews} against the {native} Hebrews, because their widows were being overlooked in the daily serving *of food*.
- KJV Acts 6:1 And in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplied, there arose a murmuring of the Grecians against the Hebrews, because their widows were neglected in the daily ministration.
- Acts 20:19 serving the Lord with all humility and with tears and with trials which came upon me through the plots of the Jews;
- Rom. 7:25 Thanks be to God through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, on the one hand I myself with my mind am serving the law of God, but on the other, with my flesh the law of sin.
- Rom. 12:7 if service, in his serving; or he who teaches, in his teaching; KJV Rom. 12:7 Or ministry, let us wait on our ministering: or he that teacheth, on teaching;
- Rom. 12:11 not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;
- Phil. 2:22 But you know of his proven worth that he served with me in the furtherance of the gospel like a child *serving* his father.
- I Pet. 4:10 As each one has received a *special* gift, employ it in serving one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
- KJV I Pet. 4:10 As every man hath received the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.
